TERMS AND CONDITIONS



The rules and regulation stipulated below are in addition to the constitution of the Charlo Supporters Club (CSC)

1.

INTRODUCTION:

- 1.1 The CSC's members and activities must adhere to all regulations as stipulated in the constitution.
- 1.2 The constitution is available from the CSC Chairman.
- 1.3 Membership is free to all Charlo supporters, although a donation of R100 would be appreciated and will ensure your name being adorned onto a brick in the club.

2. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 2.1 CSC, its committee members, affiliates, officers, agents, contractors, successors and assigns do not accept any liability for any damages or losses whatsoever, arising out of, or in any way related to, the use of this club.
- 2.2 CSC is a fully licenced club. The sale of or supply of alcohol to a juvenile (a person under the age of 18 years) IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.
- 2.3 Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
- 2.4 It is an offence to sell or supply alcohol to any person who is already affected by liquor to the point of being drunk.
- 2.5 Any person that is behaving in an offensive manner including being violent, quarrelsome, disorderly or indecent will be removed from the club. We reserve the right to shut the bar and request that the premises be emptied at any point in the evening if our rules are persistently or grossly ignored.
- 2.6 NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES MAY BE REMOVED FROM THE CLUB AT ANY TIME.
- 2.7 No smoking is allowed inside the CSC. Smokers, when outside, are asked to keep noise to a minimum and to keep the premises free of cigarette butts.
- 2.8 The main entrance to the clubhouse must be kept free of any obstructions.
- 2.9 The Club will only officially operate during Wednesdays and Friday evenings. Permission will have to be acquired from the Headmaster for ad hoc functions.
- 2.10 Any officer or any member of the Committee shall have power to order the immediate withdrawal from the Club's premises of any member offending under the provisions of this rule and the member may be dealt with by the Committee under the disciplinary rule. Such a member shall have no right of re-entry to the Club premises or benefits of membership until requested and attending to meet the Committee.
- 2.11 Members shall be expected to maintain a reasonable standard of dress and shall under no circumstances wear clothing deemed to be offensive to other members of the club.
- 2.12 Members may bring guests to CSC and has to sign a guest book. The member takes full responsibility of the guest. Guests are not allowed to be present in the club without the presence of members.
- 2.13 Any member or their guest(s) who cause damage to the club, or property for which the club is responsible for, will make full restitution for that damage.

- 2.14 All members and guests making use of the facilities on Charlo Primary School premises shall respect the privacy of the surrounding residents. Members and guests shall behave in an unobtrusive manner, especially when entering and leaving the premises.
- 2.15 The CSC does not provide security and will not be liable for any loss or damage incurred by third parties.
- 2.16 By completion and signing the CSC membership form, you agree to abide by all policies and regulation adopted by the CSCC.
