



NOTICE REGARDING ACADEMIC WORK FOR THE INTERMEDIATE AND SENIOR PHASE DURING LOCKDOWN

Dear Parents/Guardians

The following notice serves to inform you about the academic work that Intermediate and Senior Phase students can complete during the lockdown.

At this point in time, we would prefer that the work done at home focuses on revision rather than the learning of new concepts and skills. We would greatly appreciate it if our parents and guardians can assist us with the following activities to stimulate learning at home:

- Practise reading aloud by revising content covered during the first term. This content can be found in all the content subject textbooks as well as stories read in the language textbooks.
- Practise writing by creating summaries of content covered during the first term. These summaries will be very beneficial when exams commence as the exams will focus on work covered during the first two terms.
- Practise basic mathematical skills including addition, subtraction, multiplication and division completed during the first term. Please see examples in textbooks to ensure that questions are at the correct learner level.
- Practise the 1 to 12 multiplication tables.
- Term two content may also be read and discussed with learners for extra stimulation.

In the case that the lockdown is extended, we will facilitate a process of sending academic work home that learners need to complete on a weekly basis. This work will be revised when learners return to school. All work will be communicated through School Communicator. More specific details will be given should we get to that point.
