CHARLO PRIMARY SCHOOL'S COVID-19 POLICY AGAINST STIGMATISATION

At Charlo Primary:

- The rights of all learners, educators, workers, and parents at Charlo Primary School are respected.
- Learners, educators, and workers with COVID-19 are managed appropriately
- Further spreading of COVID-19 infection is prevented
- A non-discriminatory and caring learning environment is created

STEPS THAT THE STAFF OF CHARLO PRIMARY WILL TAKE TO PREVENT STIGMATISATION

- Educate teachers and learners on what the symptoms of COVID-19 are.
- Educate teachers and learners on how COVID-19 spreads
- Educate teachers and learners on Charlo Primary's prevention policy of COVID-19

LEARNERS OR TEACHERS WHO TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID-19:

Learners/teachers who had COVID-19 should not be denied the opportunity to reach their full potential. Their needs should be accommodated as far as is reasonably possible within the school environment or through home schooling if necessary. Any special measures taken must be fair, medically justifiable and taken in consultation with the learner and parent.

Any learner or staff member who discriminates against any other person who has or had recovered from COVID-19, may be disciplined if found guilty during a disciplinary hearing.

The following will be seen as discrimination:

- Calling of names
- Pushing a person out of a group/class/lesson on grounds of his/her medical history
- Refusing a person any of the rights that other children have at school
- However, this is not a closed list of factors of what may amount to discrimination.
