Stationery and requirements:

1. 6 HB pencils / 0.5 Pacer and lead
2. Soft eraser
3. A pair of scissors
4. 30 cm ruler (bendable rulers and rulers with multiplication tables / calculators are NOT allowed)
5. Sharpener
6. 3 large Pritt (send one to school, keep the others at home)
7. 1 pack of sticky notes
8. 3 highlighters – different colours
9. 1 pack of white board markers (black, green, red, blue)
10. 2 Pilot Frixion Erasable pens (1 royal blue & 1 red)
11. 1 pack of 24 colouring pencils
12. 4 A4 plastic button envelopes (1 blue, 1 red, 1 green, 1 yellow)
